2020 LA Trapshooting State Shoot Reschedule 3/26/2020 Teleconference

2. 2020 State Shoot Rescheduling

- a. The status of the state shoot schedule vs the current virus restrictions was discussed at length.
- b. It was noted that the ATA had responded to Doyle's inquiry that yes, the state shoot could be delayed into the beginning of next year's target year such as in September or October but that the targets and All American points would be counted in the following year's accounting.
- c. Dates under consideration for rescheduling by the Board are the weekend of July 25th and sometime during the month of September. It was noted that it is extremely hot in July and that the date is just before the Grand and two weeks after MS's rescheduled state shoot. It was discussed that shorter days come into play for later than September and that hunting season could affect the number of shooters.
- d. Presquid was discussed. The site can move the entire presquid shooters to the new dates. It was agreed that if someone can't attend the new dates, they will be refunded their \$2 /

event if they cancel more than 30 days in advance of the new dates. Checks will have to be issued by the LTA to refund their monies.

- e. The financial impact of cancelling vs rescheduling was discussed. If the shoot is cancelled, the LTA still must pay for the trophies. Without other expenses being incurred such as the Saturday night meal, the impact for the year would be minimal unless the donations made are returned. In that event the impact is quite large pushing the revenues for the year greatly into the red. If the shoot is rescheduled, the primary risk is a reduction in the number of participants.
- f. The Board was requested to consider how donations would be handled if it is decided to cancel the shoot.
- g. After it was discussed that no one thought the shoot could occur on the current scheduled dates, a vote was held and passed that the shoot would be rescheduled.
- h. After discussions that it may be a more negative impact to the shoot if it has to be postponed twice, a vote was held and passed that the rescheduled dates would not be decided until after another Board meeting to be held on 4/22 so that additional information could be obtained regarding where the virus restrictions are headed.
